(College Goal Sunday – 1/30/2011 @ Chiefess MS, 1:00pm)</li> <li>★ Go through college catalogs and find schools of interest!</li> <li>★ During college visits, make sure you meet with an Admissions Rep and a Financial Aid Officer</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Take the ACT test if necessary- <b><u>February 12, 2011</u></b></li> <li>★ Start looking into private scholarships and other student aid programs. Ask your counselor if there are any local organizations offering free use of a scholarship search program</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Continue looking into outside funding sources.</li> <li>★ Register and study for the SAT (I &amp; II) and/or the ACT exams.</li> <li>★ <b><u>March 12, 2011- SAT</u></b></li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Choose your top 3-5 colleges and if appropriate, start planning for an overnight visit and apply for an interview.</li> <li>★ <b><u>April 9, 2011- ACT</u></b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Take the SAT (I or II) and/or the ACT exams</li> <li>★ <b><u>May 7, 2011- SAT</u></b></li> <li>★ Be aware of test dates and registration deadlines. You may also take the SAT/ACT in your senior year.</li> <li>★ Continue to look into scholarships.</li> <li>★ Take the AP exam if applicable.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Take the SAT, SAT Subject Test and/or ACT exams!</li> <li>★ <b><u>June 4, 2011- SAT</u></b></li> <li>★ <b><u>June 11, 2011 - ACT</u></b></li> <li>★ Read widely and review your math skills over the summer!</li> <li>★ Obtain a summer job that might be related to your career interests!</li> <li>★ Relax and recoup for your final year in High School!</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Visit Colleges</li> <li>★ Request College Applications</li> <li>★ Begin to narrow down your college search list!</li> </ul>
